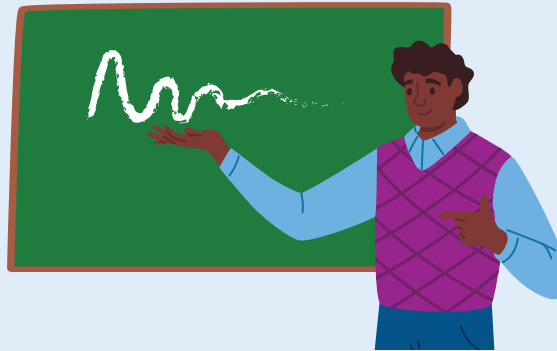

WHY CAN I GET VACCINATED?

Babies or toddlers: 0 to 3 years

- at Kind en Gezin
- at your doctor's surgery

Children: 3 to 8 years

- at the CLB (at school)
- at your doctor's surgery

Adults: over 18 years of age

- at your doctor's surgery
- at work
- at the pharmacy (only in the case of COVID-19 and flu)

When travelling:

- at the travel clinic
- at your doctor's surgery

The Flemish authorities offer vaccines free of charge to certain target groups. Vaccines that need to be paid for can be bought at the pharmacy. In some cases, these vaccines will be fully (or partially) reimbursed by the federal authorities or your health insurer.
